

Knitkinz Red, Blue and White Pants and T-short



Blue, Red and White Pants (1 piece)

- Cast on 21 stitches using blue yarn; needles #3.
- Rows 1,4,7,10: Blue yarn; (1K, 1P)* to the end of row
- Rows 2,5,8,11: White yarn; (1K, 1P)* to the end of row
- Rows 3,6,9: Red yarn; (1K, 1P)* to the end of row
- Leave on a separate needle. Cast on 21 stitches and knit 11 rows following the same pattern; then put both parts on the same needle and knit as 1 piece.
- Row 12: Red yarn; 19 (1K, 1P)*; 3(P2tog); 19 (1K, 1P)* to the end of row.
- Rows 13,16,19: Blue yarn; (1K, 1P)* to the end of row
- Rows 14,17,20: White yarn; (1K, 1P)* to the end of row
- Rows 15,18,21: Red yarn; (1K, 1P)* to the end of row
- Row 22: Blue yarn; all knit
- Rows 23,24: Blue yarn; (2Ptog, 2P)* to the end of row
- Cast off
- Using long tail thread, mattress stitch seams together.

Red and White T-short

Front and Back (2 pieces)

- Cast on 17 stitches using red yarn.
- Rows 1,3: (1K, 1P)*
- Row 2: (1P, 1K)*.
- Rows 4,10,16: All Purl
- Rows 5,11,17: All Knit
- Rows 6,8,12,14,18: All Purl
- Rows 7,9,13,15: All Knit.
- Row 19: Knit 6. Close 6 stitches. Continue knitting 6 stitches (all Knit) keeping them on a separate needle.
- Row 20,22: All Purl.
- Row 21,23: All Knit
- Cast off
- Row 20 (continued): Attach a thread so you can continue knitting the remaining 6 stitches. All Purl to the end of the row.
- Row 21,23: All Knit
- Row 22: All Purl
- Cast off

Sleeves (2 pieces)

- Cast on 15 stitches using white yarn.
- Rows 1-6: (1K, 1P)* to the end of row
- Cast off

Collar (1 piece)

- Cast on 35 stitches using white yarn.
- Rows 1-12: (1K, 1P)*
- Cast off

Blue Belt (1 piece)

- Cast on 4 stitches using blue yarn.
- Rows 1-12: 1P
- Cast off
