

Knitkinz Pants and Sweater



Pants (1 detail)

- Cast on 20 stitches.
- Rows 1-11: All Knit.
- Leave on a separate needle. Cast on 20 stitches and knit 11 rows (all Knit).
- Put both parts on the same needle and knit as 1 detail.
- Row 12: Knit 19; 2Ktog; All Knit. You will have 39 stitches after Row 12.
- Rows 13-19: All Knit
- Row 20,23: Knit 1; (2Ktog; Knit 4). You will have 30 stitches after this row.
- Rows 21,22,24,25: All Knit
- Close all



Striped Sweater

Front and Back (2 details)

- Cast on 17 stitches using yellow yarn.
- Rows 1,3: (1K, 1P)*; yellow yarn
- Row 2: (1P, 1K)*; yellow yarn.
- Rows 4,10,16: All Perl; cyan yarn
- Rows 5,11,17: All Knit; cyan yarn
- Rows 6,8,12,14,18: All Perl; yellow yarn
- Rows 7,9,13,15: All Knit; yellow yarn
- Row 19: Knit 6. Close 6 stitches. Continue knitting 6 stitches (all Knit) keeping them on a separate needle. Yellow yarn
- Row 20,22: All Perl; yellow yarn
- Row 21,23: All Knit
- Close all
- Row 20 (continued): Attach a thread so you can continue knitting the remaining 6 stitches. All Perl to the end of the row.
- Row 21,23: All Knit
- Row 22: All Perl
- Close all

Sleeves (2 details)

- Cast on 15 stitches using yellow yarn.
- Rows 1,3: (1K, 1P)*; yellow yarn
- Row 2: (1P, 1K)*; yellow yarn.
- Rows 4,10: All Perl; cyan yarn
- Rows 5,11: All Knit; cyan yarn
- Rows 6,8,12,14: All Perl; yellow yarn
- Rows 7,9,13: All Knit; yellow yarn
- Close all

Collar (1 detail)

- Cast on 39 stitches using yellow yarn.
- Rows 1,3,5,7: (1K, 1P)*
- Row 2,4,6: (1P, 1K)*
- Close all
