

# Mini Knitkinz Green Pants

## Green Pants (1 piece)

- Cast on 15 stitches using green yarn; needles #3.
- Rows 1-3: (1 Knit, 1 Purl)\*.
- Rows 4, 5, 6: All knit
- Odd Rows 7-13: (1 Knit, 1 Purl)\*.
- Even Rows 8-12: (1 Purl, 1 Knit)\*.
- Leave on a separate needle. Cast on 23 stitches and knit 21 rows following the same pattern; then put both parts on the same needle and knit as 1 piece.
- Row 14: 14 (1 Purl, 1 Knit)\*; 2Ptog; 14 (1 Purl, 1 Knit)\*.
- Odd rows 15, 17: (1 Knit, 1 Purl)
- Even rows 16, 18: (1 Purl, 1 Knit)\*
- Row 19: Close 14 stitches. (1K, 1P)\*.
- Row 20: Close 7 stitches. (1P, 1K)\*.
- Rows 21, 22, 23: 2Ptog, (1K, 1P)\*, 2Ptog.
- Cast off



## Stripe (1 piece)

- Cast on 5 stitches.
- Row 1-20: (1K, 1P)\*.
- Cast off

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
